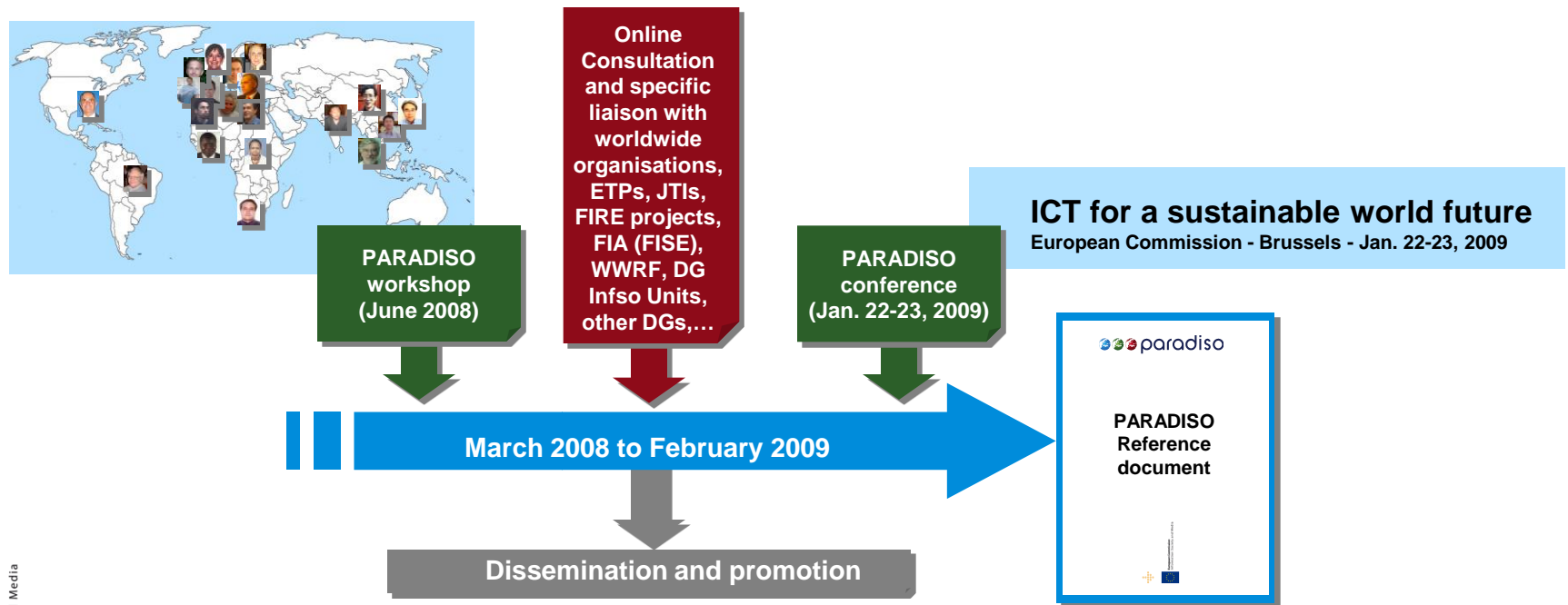

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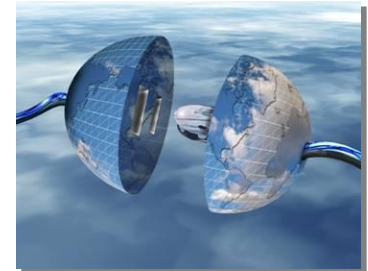
- 🌐 **ICT will play a central role in beyond GDP societies (let this be known!)**

(very) First issues, topics, research areas...

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Changing consumer patterns
 - ✓ (lower / different consumption) Meaningful and more affordable, durable, upgradeable and easy recyclable (impact on many research topics)
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New social paradigms
 - ✓ Innovative social platforms (local perspectives, social and cultural services, informal economy)
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Championing impact mitigation (and monitoring)
 - ✓ of ICT on the environment and natural resources (not only in order to avoid a “switch it off” future)
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ICT for environment, ICT4D, eInclusion
 - ✓ Far more important efforts to dedicate on these issues (including climate change: see recent US initiative)
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International cooperation
 - ✓ Not only with with developed countries, via eInfrastructures & connected testbeds, similar markets for LDC and LD part of developed countries
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Beyond GDP ICT tools
 - ✓ Advanced ICT tools are needed (serious games, social networking platforms) for policy-makers and the public at large
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Cross-disciplinary (and multi-stakeholder)
 - ✓ Necessary to combine technology driven and needs driven approaches in many research areas
